BROADCAST STYLE:

A MAN CONFINED TO A WHEELCHAIR WAS ARRESTED FOR ALLEGEDLY STEALING 6-HUNDRED DOLLARS FROM A PHOENIX WOMAN THIS MORNING.

THE ROBBER ... SUFFERING FROM CEREBRAL PALSY ... PULLED A KNIFE ON THE WOMAN AS SHE WAS TAKING MONEY OUT OF AN ATM OUTSIDE THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK AT 1<sup>ST</sup> STREET AND CENTRAL AVENUE, ACCORDING TO PHOENIX POLICE.
